Tuition Fee

The Tuition Fee ensures that the operational costs of St Bonaventure's College are met. Siblings will pay a reduced percentage of the tuition as outlined below. This Tuition Fee reduction applies to families with more than one child enrolled at St Bonaventure's College.

**** If annual fees are paid in full by the due date, families will receive a 5% discount on the Tuition Fee portion of the school fees and levies. Please contact the College Finance Office prior to payment to obtain the discount amount for your family circumstances.**

Sibling Discounts

In accordance with Brisbane Catholic Education (BCE) policy, St Bonaventure's College will apply Sibling Discount to the Tuition Fee as follows:

- Second child – 75% of the one child tuition fee charged *(25% tuition fee discount applied)*
- Third child – 50% of the one child tuition fee charged *(50% tuition fee discount applied)*
- Fourth child – 25% of the one child tuition fee charged *(75% tuition fee discount applied)*
- Additional children – no tuition fee charged *(100% tuition fee discount applied)*

Student Resources Levy

The Student Resources Levy covers all stationery (P-6) and textbooks (P-12) for your child's learning. There is no additional book list fee. The Student Resources Levy allows our staff to plan for a range of activities, including class and year level excursions, inter-school sport and providing buses for a variety of events the students attend. The Student Resources Levy is used to purchase resources that are used directly by the students in the classrooms, e.g. Mathematics, English, Science, Design, Religious Education and Visual Arts resources and materials. The Student Resources Levy includes College events, Year Level and Curriculum-based Camps (where applicable) and Retreat programs. The Student Resources Levy is applied against each student; generally, no discounts apply to this levy.

Information Technology (IT) Levy

The Information Technology (IT) Levy will ensure our students are provided with high quality technology equipment, resources and support. The IT Levy is applied against each student; generally, no discounts apply to this levy.

Family and Community Engagement (F.A.C.E.) Levy

The Family and Community Engagement (F.A.C.E.) group will use the F.A.C.E. Levy to directly support the students at St Bonaventure's College. The F.A.C.E. Levy is a family-based levy and is only applied against the fees of the eldest enrolled child.

Capital Levy

The Capital Levy will enable St Bonaventure's College to continue growing and developing and providing students with contemporary learning spaces. This levy supports the maintenance of school facilities and repayments associated with new buildings and structures. The Capital Levy is a family-based levy and is only applied against the fees of the eldest enrolled child.

Additional Fees

School Fees do not include the following:

- Instrumental music
- Representative sport and
- Optional extracurricular activities

Please note: From time to time a student activity/event may arise which may incur an additional charge. Parents will be advised in advance of the details and costs.

Enrolment Application and Acceptance Fees

Enrolment applications at St Bonaventure's College attract a non-refundable fee of \$100. This is payable on-line as part of the enrolment application process prior to an application being considered.

Upon being offered a position at St Bonaventure's College, families will be required to pay a \$100 acceptance fee to secure the 'offered' enrolment position. This acceptance fee will be applied against the first term fee account for the enrolled student. Should the student not take up the position between acceptance and start date, this fee is non-refundable.

Payment methods of fees

The College's preferred method of payment is via an instalment arrangement whereby the total annual school fees are settled by several payments spread over the period February to November. This can be 10 monthly instalments, 20 fortnightly instalments or 40 weekly instalments. The options are:

- Direct Debit – regular payment from a bank account.
- BPay – The Biller Code and Reference Number are noted on the Statement of Fees and Levies.
- Bpoint (Credit Card) – The link to this payment site can be found on the Parent Portal.

The College expects families to ensure that Fees and Levies are settled on a prompt and timely basis.
